## Salesian College Conducts Socio-economic Survey

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Salesian College Siliguri Campus, under the guidance of two faculty members organized a one day field survey in New and Old Chumta villages, Siliguri, on 27 August 2016. Twenty members from the unit flung into action to study the

socio-economic status of the villagers.

As part of the reach out programme the NSS group distributed exercise books, stationeries and sweets from the fund collected by the members participating in the field survey. Dividing themselves into four groups the survey began with the scope of each group covering 12-15 houses. Finally, the programme officially got over with an 'NSS clap' and the group returned to the college campus.
